

SELECTION FOR POSTDOCTORAL FELLOWSHIPS UNDER THE FAPESP CCD-TAEBS PROJECT
(SCIENCE CENTER FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF ASSISTIVE TECHNOLOGY FOR BILINGUAL
EDUCATION OF DEAF PEOPLE)

1. **Brief information about the Project:** The Center for Science and Technology Development for Bilingual Education of the Deaf (CCD-TAEBS), carried out in partnership with other universities in São Paulo (USP; UFABC, UFSCAR and the Municipal Education of Campinas) involves the development of applied research on language policies for the education of the deaf, with a focus on the development of bilingual teaching materials for teaching Portuguese as a second language. Postdoctoral students will participate in projects included in the four phases of the project, namely: (i) generation of records to understand the scenario (gathering information on the field of inclusive education for the deaf, analysis of documents that guide the education of the deaf in public schools, the way in which deaf students are welcomed by schools, and the sociolinguistic profile of deaf students, their demands and the demands of teachers and educational supervisors); (ii) planning of bilingual teaching materials; (iii) development of bilingual teaching materials; (iv) application of the material, evaluation of results and teacher training.

2. **Candidate requirements** (experience, only Brazilians or also foreigners, as required by the respective funding agency, etc.)

2.1. Doctorate in Literature, Applied Linguistics or Linguistics issued by a recognized institution, in an area compatible with the research lines of the CCD TAEBS;

2.2. Be willing to dedicate yourself exclusively to the activities carried out during the duration of the scholarship;

2.3. Proven previous experience in developing teaching materials for teaching additional languages;

2.4. Previous experience in research on bilingualism and heritage languages, teaching Portuguese as L2 or FL;

2.5. Experience in research on language policies and minority languages, such as LIBRAS and/or other source languages;

2.6. Meet FAPESP's prerequisites for enrollment in the Postdoctoral Program (<https://fapesp.br/bolsas/pd>).

2.7. Mastery of digital technologies for the preparation of teaching materials;

2.8. Theoretical and practical knowledge about course planning and production of teaching materials:

2.9. Proven ability to produce scientific articles.

3. Details about the Postdoctoral scholarship to be offered (Amount and duration of the scholarship, supervisor, dates, etc.);

3.1. Postdoctoral opportunities are open to Brazilians and foreigners. Those selected will receive a FAPESP Postdoctoral Fellowship in the amount of R\$12,000.00 per month and a Technical Reserve equivalent to 10% of the annual value of the fellowship to cover unforeseen expenses directly related to the research activity.

3.2. CCD-TAEBS is a FAPESP Center for Science for Development (CCD) based at the School of Medical Sciences at Unicamp.

3.3. Candidates must have defended their doctorate less than seven years ago in research-related areas. Other requirements are: good fluency in English, scientific writing skills and availability to reside in the Campinas region during the term of the scholarship.
